Remarks:

- 1 Persons of each level of the above table should meet the following qualifications:

- (1) Equivalent to Nobel Laureate Level: A Nobel Laureate, National Academician, or Professional or Scholar of equivalent qualifications.
 - (2) Distinguished Instructor Level:
 - (2.1) An university professor abroad with outstanding works receiving the international commendation in these five years.
 - (2.2) Persons with a honorable and internationally well-known status in the Academic field, and no counterparts of the same field in Taiwan.
 - (2.3) Persons with outstanding achievement in science or technology, and with appropriate work experience in a foreign country for years.
 - (3) Professor Level: A Professor or an equivalent Professional or Scholar.
 - (4) Associate Professor Level: An Associate Professor or an equivalent Professional or Scholar.
- 2 Airfare Regulations:
- (1) For employment less than three months, organizations merely pay one first class round trip airfare of the persons of the levels of the above table. After their superior organizations' approval, organizations with special requirements can pay a maximum of two business-class round trip airfares of those persons.
 - (2) For employment more than three months but less than one year, each of the round trip airfare of the person and his/her spouse's is paid once .
 - (3) For employment more than one year, the person and his/her spouse's round trip airfare will be paid for one time. Airfare may also be given for children under 18.
 - (4) For continuous service of more than five years, a maximum of NT \$30,000. for the person with a round trip airfare is paid every 5 years for visiting relatives in his/her home country.
- 3 Any foreign consultant, professional or scholar employed by organizations for more than two years, is given a move allowance of US \$2,000 for those who have dependents, US \$1,000 for single. An excess baggage payment is included in the move allowance.
- 4 During employment, each organization can adjust the payment not over this standard based on the person's academic position and expertise

- and the budgetary situation of the organization. In special circumstances, the payment could exceed the maximum after approved by Executive Yuan.
5. For special and professional case, it could be paid case by case under contract and governed by the provisions of Government Procurement Act and relevant regulations.
